Frame of the project

- Regional focus: Baltic States
- Preparatory project with a limited regional and thematical focus
- Partners: BEFs, Riga Energy Agency, Auraplan, e.u.z. (all in INTENSE)

Goals

Goal: A holistic approach

- Stakeholders: Detecting gaps at stakeholders (e.g. lecturers)
- Concepts: Explaining best practice and discussing how to transfer it under current conditions into the Baltic States
- Consumers: Discussing how to tap into the awareness and behaviour

Limitations

- Planning aspect just mentioned;
- No concrete training programmes developed
